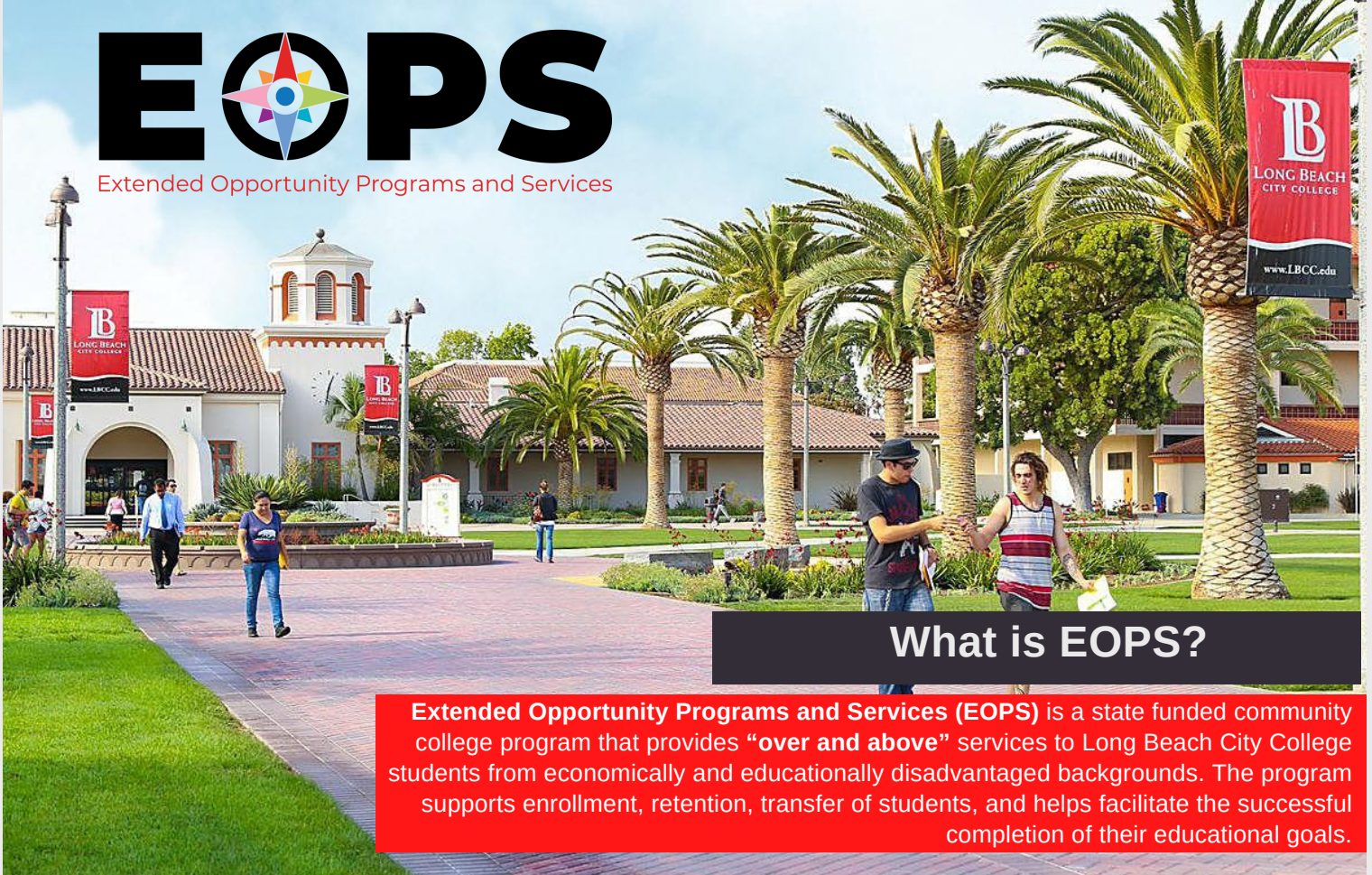

What is EOPS?

Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) is a state funded community college program that provides “**over and above**” services to Long Beach City College students from economically and educationally disadvantaged backgrounds. The program supports enrollment, retention, transfer of students, and helps facilitate the successful completion of their educational goals.



How do I qualify?

- Be a California Resident or an eligible AB540 Student / California “Dreamer”.
- Be enrolled full-time (12 or more units) at Long Beach City College (some exceptions apply).
- Have less than **69.5** degree-applicable units completed.
- Meet educationally disadvantaged criteria determined by the EOPS Program.

- Academic, Career, and Personal Counseling
- Assistance with Financial Aid (FAFSA/CADAA) & Scholarship Applications
- Book Loan Library/Textbook Assistance
- Educational and Cultural Excursions
- Grad Cap & Gowns
- Grants (*as funding permits*)
- Priority Registration (Fall & Spring Semesters)
- Specialized Student Success Workshops & On-Campus Events
- School supplies and Much More!



Student Responsibility

- Complete EOPS Orientation
- Meet with EOPS Counselor three times per semester
- Comply with EOPS Mutual Responsibility Agreement (MRA)
