AP 2745 BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

Reference:

ACCJC Accreditation Standard IV.C.10

The Superintendent-President, or designee, is responsible for administering these procedures.

In an effort to improve Board efficiency and performance, the Board will evaluate itself annually according to the following guidelines:

- A. Each year, the Board President, in consultation with the Superintendent-President, shall select a facilitator to assist the Board in the self-evaluation process. The instrument used for the self-assessment will be reviewed and revised as appropriate.
- B. The self-assessment will incorporate criteria contained in board policy regarding Board operations, as well as criteria defining board effectiveness. Each Board member will complete the self-assessment.
- C. The results of the Self-Evaluation will be included on the agenda for review and appropriate action at the Board retreat held each summer. The results will be used to help the Board set goals, which will be approved by the Board no later than the October Board Meeting.
