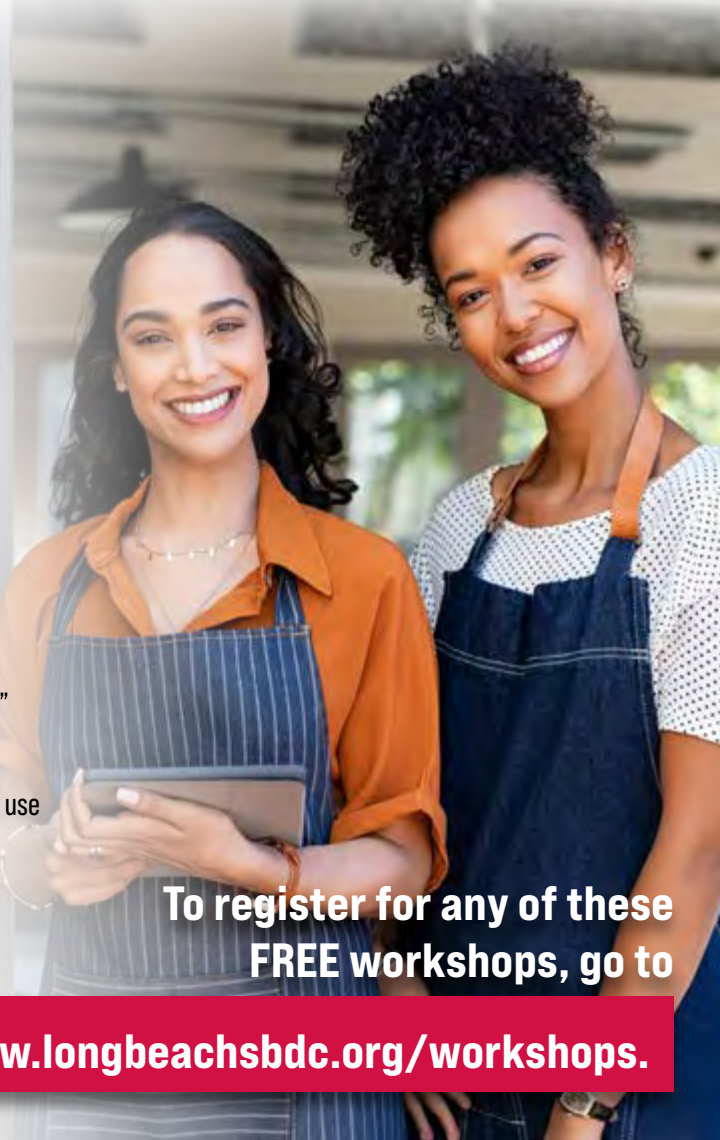

LBCC's free English as a Second Language (ESL) classes are offered at our Pacific Coast Campus - as well as online and in three community partner locations. These noncredit classes are open to people of all skill levels as a way to improve speaking and/or reading and writing in English.

These reading skills courses are designed to teach ESL students how to read, comprehend what they read, and build vocabulary. They also teach students how to read and understand sentences, paragraphs, and passages without the assistance of a dictionary.

English for Everyday

Courses in the basics of English structure are designed to bring students up to basic college level in the language. Students will be prepared for success in academic and vocational programs offered by the College. Emphasis is on the mastery of productive grammatical features and on comprehension of spoken and written standard North American English.
