## PROFICIENCIES (A.A/A.S. Degree/Graduation Requirements)

**Reading:** Successful completion with a grade of "C" or higher in READ 82, READ 83, READ 84 or higher.

A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Equivalent courses taken at

other colleges must be reviewed by Admissions & Records LBCC for approval.

Math: Completion of Math 45 or higher with a grade of "C" or better at LBCC, or placement in Math

50 or higher. A Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Equivalent courses

taken at other colleges must be reviewed by Admissions & Records LBCC for approval.

**English:** Successful completion with a grade of "C" or higher in English 1 or English 105. A Bachelor's

degree from an accredited college or university. Equivalent courses taken at other colleges

must be reviewed by Admissions & Records LBCC for approval.

## **PREREQUISITES**

<u>High School</u>: High school diploma or GED Certificate required (If High School is outside of the United States of America, Evaluation by ACEI (indicating 12<sup>th</sup> grade U.S. high school equivalency) is required, **OR** Bachelor's Degree from an accredited U.S. college or university, **OR** Associate's Degree from an accredited U.S. college or university.
