Career Opportunities

This field of concentration is designed to provide a fundamental education for a variety of specializations within the field. It also substantially fulfills lower division requirements for a baccalaureate degree in this major.

This Associate Degree will prepare students for transfer to a four-year college or university.

Program Mission and Outcomes

The mission of the Art and Photography Department at Long Beach City College is to provide students instruction in the visual arts whether beginning, advanced, or professional with a single class, general education courses, or a course of study, leading to transfer, Associate Degree, or a vocational certificate. Students can pursue their individual interests in the visual arts through an array of foundation courses establishing a technical and critical understanding of visual language.

These courses lead to improved personal creative expression or to specialized instruction in numerous areas within the creative and applied arts. The arts involve students in the process of their learning, demanding constant reflection and active participation. The arts enable students to collaborate toward a common purpose. The arts are a powerful connection force between disciplines. As our world and problems become more complex, creative thinking becomes all the more important.

Outcomes:

- Produce professional quality artwork that demonstrates skill, craftsmanship, comprehension of visual design, and aesthetic conceptual rigor.
- Develop a foundation of skills, craft, traditional, and digital technologies.
- Analyze, interpret, and exercise critical judgment in the evaluation of visual art forms.
