2032. POLICY ON RECORDING OF BOARD MEETINGS

References: California Education Code Section 72121(a)

California Government Code Sections 6250 et seq., 54953.5, 54953.6

It is the policy of the Long Beach Community College District to record its regular Board meetings. The recordings shall be subject to inspection by members of the public in accordance with the California Public Records Act, Government Code sections 6250 et seq. The recordings are maintained for at least sixty (60) calendar days following the date of recording.

Persons attending an open and public meeting of the Board may, at their own expense, record the proceedings with an audio, video, still or motion picture device or may broadcast the proceedings. In this instance, if the Board finds by a majority vote that the recording or broadcast cannot continue without noise, illumination, or obstruction of view that constitutes or would constitute a persistent disruption of the proceedings, any such person shall be directed by the President of the Board to discontinue recording or transmitting.
