2034. POLICY ON COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Reference: Government Code, Section 54952

The Board of Trustees, at its discretion, may establish committees to assist the Board in its responsibilities. Any committee established by the Board shall comply with requirements of the Brown Act.

Board committees which are composed solely of less than a quorum of members of the Board of Trustees, which are advisory, and which do not have authority that may lawfully be exercised by the Board itself and are not required to comply with the Brown Act unless they are standing committees.

Board committees have no authority or power to act on behalf of the Board of Trustees, unless the Board expressly delegates such authority or power to the committee.

Findings or recommendations of committees shall be reported to the Board of Trustees for consideration.
