The Superintendent-President shall ensure the District has and implements a broad-based comprehensive, systematic, and integrated system of planning that involves appropriate segments of the college community and is supported by institutional effectiveness research.

The plans shall include, but are not limited to the following:

- Strategic Plan
- Facilities Master Plan
- Strategic Enrollment Management Plan
- Technology Plan
- Equal Employment Opportunity Plan
- Student Equity Plan
- Transfer Center Plan
- Cooperative Work Experience Plan
- EOPS Plan

The Superintendent-President shall inform the Board of Trustees about the status of institutional plans and shall submit those plans for which Board approval is required by Title 5 to the Board of Trustees.

The Superintendent-President shall ensure the Board of Trustees has an opportunity to assist in developing the general institutional mission and goals for the strategic plan.
