BP 4106 NURSING PROGRAMS

The Long Beach Community College District shall utilize published criteria when screening prospective students for admission to the nursing program.

The Nursing Program shall operate according to the Board of Registered Nursing requirements.

Nursing students who have already earned a baccalaureate or higher degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher learning are not required to complete any general education requirements or graduation proficiencies that may be required for an associate degree. Instead, these students need to complete only the coursework necessary for licensing as a registered nurse.
