## BP 5110 COUNSELING

Counseling services are an essential part of the educational mission of the District.

The Long Beach Community College District is committed to the support of student services in general and counseling/guidance programs in particular. The District also recognizes that the people involved in student services recruit students to the college and help them to remain and profit from their educational experiences. Therefore, it shall be the policy of this District to ensure that counseling services will provide the personal attention necessary to assist students in meeting their educational goals at this institution.

The Superintendent-President shall assure the provision of counseling services including academic, career, and personal counseling that is related to the student's education.

Counseling shall be made available for all first-time students enrolled for more than six units, students enrolled provisionally, and students on academic or progress probation.
