## 6018. POLICY ON ACCESSIBILITY OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGY

The Long Beach Community College District is committed to providing equal access to electronic and information technology for all students, staff, faculty and others with disabilities in accordance with applicable federal and state laws.

Electronic and information technologies are a means by which the District provides information to students, faculty, staff, and other constituents. The need to ensure accessibility to all members of the campus community is critical as more administrative services and learning environments are based on these technologies. It is also a part of the District's ongoing commitment to establish a barrier free learning environment to all individuals.

As mandated by federal and state laws and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, it is required that the District comply with Section 508 Standards to ensure accessibility to information and communication technologies for individuals with disabilities. The Superintendent-President or designee shall act to enforce compliance with the accessibility requirements of Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended (29 U.S.C. 794d) and its implementing regulations set forth at Title 36 CFR Part 1194.
