7002. POLICY ON SMOKING IN DISTRICT FACILITIES AND VEHICLES

References: California Penal Code 626.4; Education Code Sections 76030, 87660 et seq., 88001 e), h), 88013, 88016; California Government Code Section 7597.1; Government Code Sections 19994.30, 19994.35; Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges' Resolution for a Smoke and Tobacco-Free Community College System (approved May 14, 2018).

It is the policy of the Long Beach Community College District to provide a safe and healthy environment for its students, employees, and visitors. In light of evidence that the use of tobacco and nicotine and exposure to secondhand smoke and aerosol (commonly referred to as "vapor") from electronic devices pose significant health and environmental hazards, the District has established a smoke-, vapor-, and tobacco-free environment.

Smoking of any kind, including use of electronic devices, and all uses of tobacco are prohibited on all property and in all indoor and outdoor spaces owned, leased, licensed, or otherwise controlled by the District, and in all District-owned vehicles.
