Subject: Board Decision Regarding Consideration of Report of Program Records Survey for Continued Program Approval

Dear Rhonda Alger,

The Executive Officer, on 4/20/2021, considered the consultant's report regarding the Long Beach City College Vocational Nursing Program – Consideration of the Report of Program Records Survey for Continued approval.

The following decisions were rendered:

1. Grant continued full approval for the Long Beach City College Vocational Nursing Program for a four-year period beginning May 11, 2021 and issue a certificate accordingly.
2. Comply with all program requirements listed below.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Notify the NEC in the event a current class is displaced from clinical sites.
2. Obtain BVNPT approval prior to the admission of each class.
3. Continue to require the program, when requesting approval to admit students, to:
 - a. Submit all documentation in final form, using forms provided by the BVNPT, no later than two months prior to the requested start date for the class.
 - b. Provide documentation that adequate resources, i.e. faculty and facilities, are available to support each admitted class of students.
 - c. Maintain an average pass rate that is compliant with Section 2530(l) of the Vocational Nursing Rules and Regulations.
4. Comply with all approval standards in Article 4 of the Vocational Nursing Practice Act, commencing at Business and Professions Code Section 2880, and Article 5 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 16.
