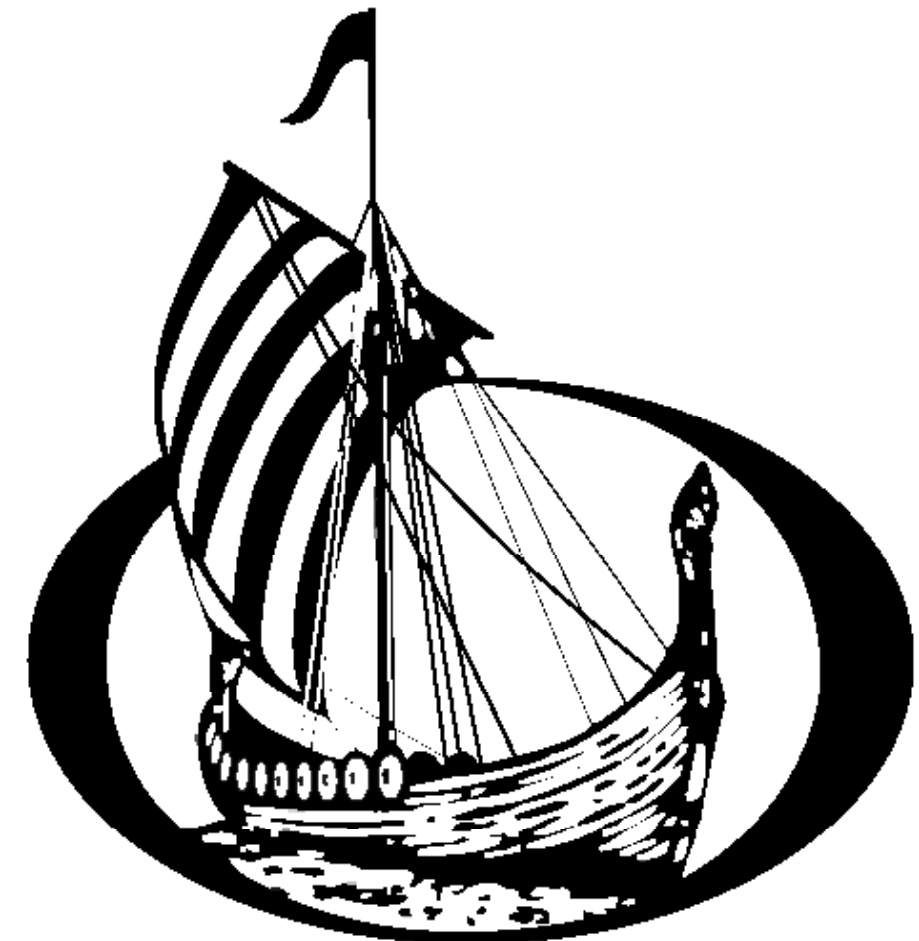

Nomination Criteria

Nominations for induction into the Long Beach City College Hall of Fame are accepted in the LBCC Alumni office throughout the academic year. An active solicitation of names occurs for one month during the spring semester. Anyone who wishes to nominate a former student for this award may do so by completing a nomination form or by submitting a letter of nomination. Please include any available background information such as resume, newspaper or magazine clippings, etc.

Hall of Fame Selection Criteria

Potential candidates should meet the following criteria:

- Ten years must have elapsed since candidates attended Long Beach City College.
- Candidates must have a proven track record of achievement in their chosen career, service to the community, or area of endeavor.
- Candidates must have gained local, state, or national recognition.

Hall of Fame Selection Process

- Representatives from the Associated Student Body (ASB), in conjunction with the Alumni Director, meet during the spring semester to review candidate nomination applications and will forward up to ten candidates for further consideration. Past Hall of Fame nominees as well as candidates who have received the Distinguished Alumni Award may be considered as nominees.
- Selected candidates may include Distinguished Alumni award recipients, and nominees from current and/or previous nominations lists.
- Final review and selection is made by a committee comprised of the Superintendent-president, a representative from the Long Beach Community College District Board of Trustees, the Foundation Executive Director, Alumni Director.
- The LBCC Alumni office distributes the Hall of Fame nomination forms to past inductees, active alumni members, the Foundation Board of Governors, faculty and staff, elected officials, community organizations, and the media. Anyone may obtain a nomination form by contacting the LBCC Alumni office.
- During the summer, representatives from the Hall of Fame planning committee visit the chosen candidates to inform them of their selection. The official Hall of Fame induction ceremony will take place during the fall semester.
