Re-Dedication and Open House of Student Services Center at Long Beach City College

LONG BEACH, CA – The one-stop Student Services Center located in the landmark building of Long Beach City College will be re-dedicated as the Gateway to the Liberal Arts Campus. An Open House of Building A, originally built in 1940, will be hosted by the Long Beach Community College District (LBCCD) Board of Trustees and Long Beach City College (LBCC) Leadership.

WHAT: LBCC's Student Services Center, a place where students can easily access all student services, will be re-dedicated with the unveiling of a plaque, refreshments, giveaways and tours of the following areas:

Student Relations, Health Services, Enrollment Services, Matriculation, Admissions and Records, Financial Aid, Veteran Affairs, Cashier's Office/ASB Bank, Career and Transfer Services, International Students, Counseling, Disabled Students Programs and Services (DSPS), Extended Opportunity and Services, CalWORKs, 21 walk-up computer stations throughout the building for student accessibility, and the Courtyard's Rose Garden.

The two-year retrofitting 33,967 square feet project of \$8.2M was funded by Measure E, a facilities construction and modernization bond measure, approved by the voters of the LBCCD in 2008.
