



EOPS STUDENT STANDARDS OF PARTICIPATION & ELIGIBILITY LIMITATIONS

Standards of Participation

In order to remain continuously eligible for EOPS Services all EOPS students must:

- Complete three counseling contacts each term.
Excessive missed appointments will affect your services
- Complete a minimum of 9 units in the previous term with satisfactory grades.
- Maintain a cumulative 2.0 GPA each term.
- Complete Counseling 49 by the end of the first year in EOPS.
- Follow all other guidelines as stipulated in the Mutual Responsibility Agreement (MRA).

Missing any one of the above requirements in a given semester will result in the following:

- **1st Term Non-compliance-** Student receives a warning notice. Must complete the 1st contact of the next term before full services are provided in that term.
- **2nd Term Non-compliance-** Student receives basic services only in the following term (no book grant).
- **3rd Term Non-compliance-** Student is dismissed from the program. Must sit out for one term and reapply to the program.
- Students may file an appeal of dismissal with the director in cases of extenuating circumstances.

NOTE

1. Breaking continuous participation may affect your ability to be readmitted to EOPS. Skipping a semester means reapplying to the program; if there is space available at the time you reapply, you may be readmitted.
2. Please remember that children are not allowed on school premises, including during EOPS appointments.

Eligibility Limitations

Once admitted into EOPS, students are eligible for the program until:

- Completion of a total of 70 degree applicable units from all accredited colleges attended—OR—
- Completion of six consecutive semesters of participation in EOPS (not including summer sessions)—AND/OR—
- The student has not made adequate progress toward a declared goal—AND/OR—
- The student has continually not met Mutual Responsibility Agreement requirements (MRA).
