


Memorandum of Understanding

2012 Summer Intersession
AGREEMENT
January 23, 2012


Due to severe budget constraints; and in order to best meet the needs of the students of Long Beach City College; and in order to fund a reduced summer intersession for summer 2012, the District and CCA agree that the District will offer a single reduced summer intersession to be implemented as follows:

1. Total expenditures for full time faculty at the current contracted summer rate shall not exceed 25% of overall summer intersession expenditures. This percentage shall include any retirees who remain eligible for summer contract rate per Article XIV.L;
2. Deans and department heads will work together to identify and staff a substantially reduced summer intersession whereby only essential (core) courses will be offered within specific budgetary limitations that will be provided by the area dean;
3. Final approval of courses shall be primarily guided by the offerings under the "Golden Four" (as identified in the college catalog as areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 of California State University General Education Requirements) and selected basic skills offerings (as identified by the area dean);
4. The Deans shall have final approval over the summer schedule but must abide by the criteria outlined above.


This agreement eliminates the need for a negotiated pay cut specific to the summer 2012 intersession whereby the District had proposed paying faculty at their hourly rate in order to avoid the cancelling of summer intersession for 2012. This MOU applies only to summer 2012 and is non-precedent setting.
