UC and CSU Transfer Counts

This information is available from the California Post-Secondary Education Commission (CPEC). The source for these counts are the University of California (UC) and the California State University (CSU) systems. The UC and CSU report the transfer source institution as the community college where the student earned the most transferable units. The number of units earned is not a consideration. Transfer students are undergraduates.

Out-of-State and In-State Private Transfer Counts

In fall 2005, Long Beach City College purchased a subscription to the National Student Clearinghouse (NSCH) database. NSCH is an industry-sponsored consortium with over 2,800 participating colleges (91% of all U.S. colleges and universities) and more than 75 million current and former post-secondary student enrollment data. By matching LBCC students and their subsequent enrollment in another institution, student transfers to private and out-of-state colleges and universities can be identified. The table below describes the students who successfully completed 12 or more transferable units at LBCC, attempted either a transfer math and/or English course, and subsequently enrolled in any private, for-profit, or out-of-state college/university.
