Three Components to Success:

1. **English:** Take English 105 and English 1 to improve your writing skills in a supportive environment. The content of both classes focuses on subjects and literature related to the Chicano and Latino experience.
2. **Counseling:** Work closely with the Puente counselor to improve your study skills, explore career options, develop an academic educational plan, and identify lifetime goals.
