

Licensing and Examination Pass Rates for Cal Grant Qualifying Institutions

This page has been created as an access point for prospective and current students to view licensing information and examination passage rates for graduates of undergraduate programs leading to employment for which passage of a California licensing examination is required. Assembly Bill (AB) 2086 amends Section 69432.7 of the California Education Code and requires Cal Grant participating institutions to provide information on where to access California license examination passage rates if this data is electronically available through the website of a California licensing or regulatory agency.
