POLICY ON BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

Reference: Accreditation Standard IV.B.1.e and g

The Board is committed to assessing its own performance as a board in order to identify its strengths and areas in which it may improve its functioning.

A self-assessment survey form, approved by the Board, will be used as a tool in the Board self-evaluation process and will incorporate criteria contained in Board Policy regarding board operations as well as criteria defining board effectiveness. Each Board member will complete a self-evaluation survey form and submit it to the Board Secretary. The self-assessment will occur once each year at a time established by the Board.

A summary of the evaluations will be presented and discussed at a board session scheduled for that purpose. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
