

3002. POLICY ON ALLEGATIONS OF UNLAWFUL DISCRIMINATION

It is the policy of the Long Beach Community College District to promote equal opportunity in its programs and activities without regard to a person's race, religious creed, color, age (over 40), gender, sexual orientation, national origin, ancestry, marital status, medical condition or disability (including AIDS), or obligations to the National Guard or Reserve forces of the United States. No person shall be subjected to discrimination on these or any other basis forbidden by law in any program or activity conducted under the auspices of the District. It is the policy of the District to provide a fair and just process for resolving allegations of unlawful discrimination.
