What to do in an active killer situation:

RUN: Get as far away as possible to safe location.

- Getting away from the killer is the top priority. Have an escape route in mind.
- Leave your belongings behind and get away. If possible, take your cellphone with you to call/text 911 once in a safe location.
- Call 911 when you are safe, and describe killer, location, and weapons.
- Help others escape, if possible, but evacuate regardless of whether others agree to follow.
- Warn and prevent others from entering an area where the active killer may be located.

HIDE: If escape is not possible

- Get out of the killer's view and stay quiet.
- Your hiding place should be out of the killer's view and provide protection if shots are fired.
- Lock and block doors, close blinds, and turn off lights.
- Silence all electronic devices and make sure they won't vibrate.
- Don't hide in groups, spread out along walls or hide separately.
- Stay in place until College Emergency Notification System has given an "all clear" signal.

FIGHT: Quietly commit to a plan of action

- Commit to your actions and act as aggressively as possible against the killer.
- Recruit others to ambush the killer with makeshift weapons like chairs, fire extinguishers, scissors, books, etc.
- Be prepared to cause severe or lethal injury to the killer.
- Throw items to distract and disarm the killer.
