NEW Orientation Course starting fall 2023!

Education fieldwork students now take EDUC 250 or EDUC 650, Teacher Preparation Orientation class to register for their EDUC 10, EDUC 20 or EDUC 130 classes and to be placed in a local public school for fieldwork hours. (This new process replaces former orientation workshops that were held in past semesters.)

For those students who later take an additional EDUC fieldwork course, our program will contact you directly to renew your clearances as needed. You will not need to take the Orientation class more than once.
