### For **CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT**:

This certificate is a one to two year program in occupational/technical areas at Long Beach City College which provide training in job skills and employment opportunities. Complete the required units with a minimum grade of "C" in each course and a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 ("C" average). Submit completed application for the certificate in the Admissions and Records Office during the final semester of coursework. Fifty per cent (50%) or more of the unit requirements for this field of concentration must be completed in residence (credit earned by exam, where applicable, may be included).
