Refusing your Federal Pell Grant will also make you ineligible for the FSEOG Grant. If you decide to apply for a Direct Loan by federal regulation the amount you would have received in the Pell Grant will be used in calculating your eligibility for the loan. **Declining the Pell Grant now does not guarantee your eligibility for it in the future or for any other financial aid program now or in the future.** Eligibility is recalculated each year and you may not be eligible in the future.
