Please note that completion of an A.A./A.S. degree does not automatically qualify a student to transfer. Students planning to transfer to a CSU or UC school should refer to the CSUGE-B or IGETC General Education Course Patterns (Plan B or Plan C at http://osca.lbcc.edu/genedplan.cfm) and consult with a counselor to determine the best general education pattern.

 ■ MATHEMATICS: Successful completion with a grade of "C" or higher in a college math course at the level of MATH 120 or 130 or 130A or 140 or 115 or higher OR transcript verified completion with a grade of "C" or higher in a high school Math class at the level of Intermediate Algebra. ■ READING— Proficiency may be achieved by satisfying one of the followiing: a. A qualifying placement through LBCC multiple assessment measures. b.
