

4002. POLICY ON DISABLED STUDENT PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

It is the policy of Long Beach Community College District to provide a procedure for responding, in a timely manner, to accommodation requests of students with verified disabilities involving reasonable accommodations, academic adjustments, technology accessibility, accessible facilities and equipment, and instructional programs. Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS) shall be the primary provider for accommodations and adjustments. This policy is designed to provide a procedure for the review of academic requirements to ensure that such requirements do not discriminate against students with disabilities or have the effect of excluding students solely on the basis of disability. The Superintendent-President in consultation with the Vice President, Student Support Services and Vice President, Academic Affairs shall ensure that the DSPS program and faculty adhere to all requirements established by relevant laws and regulations. The policy and procedure will be enacted in conjunction with Board Policy 5021 and Administrative Regulation 5021.
