

4011. ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS ON SCHOLARSHIP

4011.1 The Vice President of Academic Affairs is responsible for the implementation of these regulations.

4011.2 Definitions:

- A. Grade Point Average (GPA) - The grade point average is determined by dividing the grade points by the units attempted. "Units attempted" are classes with grades of A, B, C, D, or F.
- B. Grade Points - Grade points are determined by multiplying the units for each class by the value of each letter grade (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0). Grades of P, NP, MW, and W do not earn grade points nor are they used to determine Grade Point Average.

4011.3 Requirements:

Long Beach City College acknowledges outstanding student scholarship through the Dean's List produced each semester and through Honors at Graduation.

- A. Outstanding Scholarship shall be classified as follows:

1. Scholarship with Honors	3.500 - 3.749 GPA
2. Scholarship with Distinction	3.750 - 3.999 GPA
3. Scholarship with Great Distinction	4.000 GPA
- B. Dean's List - Students who are on the Dean's List are recognized at the close of each semester. All students with 6 or more "units attempted" that semester who have an overall completion ratio of at least 75% AND who maintain the necessary grade point average to qualify for "outstanding scholarship" as classified above.
- C. Honors at Graduation - All students who have attained the necessary cumulative GPA (based on all degree applicable coursework as referenced in regulations 4019) to qualify as outstanding scholars as classified above will be recognized as such upon the awarding of the degree.
- D. GPA Determination for Graduation - The GPA determination for graduation and honors at graduation will include all coursework of any

college from which any credits are applied toward the degree, except coursework which is not accepted by Long Beach City College, such as upper division work.
