## **BP 4225 COURSE REPETITION**

## References:

Education Code Section 76224; Title 5 Sections 55040, 55041, 55042, 55043, 55253, 56029, and 58161

To provide students with equitable educational opportunities, the Long Beach Community College District has determined reasonable limitations on credit course repetition. Students may repeat credit courses in which substandard grades of D, F, or NP, and the non-evaluative symbol of W were earned.

When course repetition occurs, the student's permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, ensuring a true and complete academic history.

Under special circumstances and with specific limitations, a student may repeat courses in which a C or better grade was earned. The special circumstances are defined in the Administrative Procedures.
