

POLICY ON SEXUAL MISCONDUCT

It shall be the policy of the Long Beach Community College District to direct the Superintendent/President to establish procedures for reporting, investigating and resolving complaints about sexual misconduct as well as the imposition of discipline on students in accordance with the requirements for due process set forth in federal and state law and regulations.

The procedures shall define what constitutes sexual misconduct that is subject to discipline, per *BP/AP 5012: Student Conduct*, and shall also define the procedures for investigating reports of sexual misconduct.

The procedures shall be made widely available to students through the District's website and other means.
