Administrative Procedure Chapter 5 – Student Services

AP 5203 LACTATION ACCOMMODATION

Reference:

Education Code Section 66271.9

The District shall provide reasonable accommodations, on its respective campuses, for a lactating student to express breast milk, breast-feed an infant child, or address other needs related to breast-feeding whenever a student is required to be present on campus. Reasonable accommodations include, but are not limited to, all of the following:

- 1. Access to a private and secure room, other than a restroom, to express breast milk or breast-feed an infant child. The room shall have a comfortableplace to sit and have a table or shelf to place equipment described in accommodation (2).
- 2. Ability to bring a breast pump and any other equipment used to express breast milk onto campus.
- 3. Access to a power source for a breast pump or any other equipment used to express breast milk.
- 4. Access to a refrigerator to store milk as necessary.

Lactating students shall be provided a reasonable amount of time to accommodate their need to express breast milk or breast-feed an infant child. Lactation/nursing rooms are located in LAC Health Center (A-1010) room A-1020, TTC Health Center (GG-117) room GG-120, LAC building T, and TTC – GG-144.

Students shall not incur an academic penalty as a result of their use of the reasonable accommodations and shall be provided the opportunity to make up any work missed due to such use.
