POLICY ON FACILITIES USE

Reference: California Education Code Sections 81378, 82537, 82542

It is the policy of Long Beach Community College District to grant use of District facilities to qualified groups. Requests for use will be considered only after the needs of the District have been met.

The Superintendent-President or designee shall establish regulations regarding the use of college property, including but not limited to facilities, equipment and supplies, by community groups and other outside contractors. The regulations shall reflect the requirements of applicable law, including Education Code Section 82537, regarding Civic Centers. The regulations shall include reasonable rules regarding the time, place and manner of use of District facilities. They shall assure that persons or organizations using college property are charged such fees as are authorized by law, Public use of District property shall not interfere with scheduled instructional programs or other activities.

No group or organization may use District property for purposes that discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, disability, sex (i.e. gender), or sexual orientation.
