


Bicycle Theft Prevention

LBCC Campus Police would like to provide you with the following tips to prevent bike theft.

BICYCLE THEFT PREVENTION TIPS:

- Buy/use a quality lock (preferably a "U" type lock).
- For extra security, add a cable or chain to secure the wheels.
- Lock at least one wheel (preferably two) along with the frame to the bicycle rack.



- If your bike has a quick release front wheel, remove the wheel and lock it to the rack with the frame and rear wheel.
- Keep a record of your bicycle serial/frame number, which is usually located on the underside of the bicycle's frame/crank shaft area. This will be the ONLY way to recover/return your bicycle back to you
- Consider registering your bicycle with https://project529.com/garage or through their free mobile app.
- Be observant around the bike racks, even if your bike is not there. Watch for suspicious people or someone "checking out bikes." Most people walk directly to their bike. A person going bike-to-bike may be looking for an unlocked bike to steal.

If you see someone acting suspiciously around a campus bike rack, CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY.

- If your bicycle is stolen on campus, report the theft to Campus Police at (562) 938-4910.
 - Have the following information available for the officer taking the report:
 - Serial number ***Absolutely necessary to recover/return your bicycle to you***
 - Make and model
 - Color
 - Style (Mountain, road, men's, women's)
 - Approximate value
