Subject: Board Decision Regarding Consideration of Report of Program Records Survey for Continued Approval

Dear Ms. McGill:

On June 5, 2017, the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians considered the consultant's report relative to the ***Long Beach City College Vocational Nursing Program*** - Consideration of Report of Program Records Survey for Continued Approval.

The following decisions were rendered:

1. Continue full approval of the Long Beach City College Vocational Nursing Program for the period of May 12, 2017 through May 11, 2021, and issue a certificate accordingly.
2. Continue approval of the program's current pattern of admissions, with the following stipulations:
 - a. No additional classes are added to the program's pattern of admissions without prior Board approval. The program's pattern of admissions will include admission of two (2) full-time classes of 45 students each year, one (1) class in the fall semester and one (1) class in the spring semester.
 - b. The director documents that adequate resources, i.e. faculty and facilities, are available to support each admitted class of students.
 - c. The program maintains an average annual pass rate that is compliant with Section 2530 (l) of the Code.
