We have worked to eliminate our\$3.6 million 2018-19 budgeted deficit. Expenses have been reduced by a combination of spending reductions and reorganization savings. Some of the salary savings are one-time due to vacancies, which are being refilled. So, challenges remain to fund ongoing salaries, step and negotiated increases as well as known benefit increases. The Governor's proposal to reduce the employer STRS rate increase in 2019-20 will definitely help, but still leaves a substantial increase. That along with PERS and health and welfare increases add up to about a \$2 million increase for 2019-20. Combined salary and benefits increases more than exhaust the projected COLA revenue increases.

With only hold harmless funding for the foreseeable future, we continue using strategies which focus on enrollment management and efforts to try to increase enrollment and degree completion metrics. We continue to implement our deficit reduction plan into next year.
