\$150 million in Bond Anticipation Notes (BAN) were issued January 7, 2010. The proceeds enable us to continue bond construction projects. The notes are scheduled to be repaid in three years.

This year we continue to closely monitor budgets and cash flow to cope with State budget cuts and deferrals. Next year we will continue to monitor spending and to make financial projections in anticipation of continued budget difficulties in Fiscal year 2010-11. We are currently pojecting over \$3.5 million in additional cost/revenue reductions for Fiscal Year 2010-11 that we have started to address. To assist with cash flow the district is preparing to issue Tax and Revenue Anticipation Notes (TRANs) on July 1, 2010 for \$10 million.
