In December 2014, the Board approved the revised CCA Full-time Faculty Salary Schedule, which was part of the Tentative Agreement ratified by union membership. The agreement completely restructured the salary schedule. Increases to individual faculty vary depending on their place on the schedule. The average increase in 2014-15 is estimated at 3.39%. The new salary schedule became effective November 1, 2014. Increase to be funded from increased apportionment revenue (8611) and prior years' budget savings.
