## 6014. <u>ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS ON</u> CELLULAR TELEPHONE USE

- The Vice President, Administrative Services or designee will administer these Administrative Regulations.
- Employees provided with District-paid cellular telephones are required to maintain supporting documentation regarding personal and business use of the District-provided telephone to permit the District to include a pro rata share of the value of the telephone and the monthly service charges for personal cellular telephone use.
  - A. The Fiscal Services department will send the bill for District-paid cellular telephones to affected employees on a monthly basis. Employees are required to reimburse the District for all personal use of District-paid cellular telephones.
  - B. The District shall monitor the cellular telephone usage of its employees to ensure their compliance with this policy. This section does not apply to cellular telephones owned by employees.
- Employees whose position and work duties require them to be away from their office regularly on District business and/or available in emergency situations after hours, who use their personal cellular telephones for District business, may be allotted a set monthly allowance in the amount of \$35.00 at the discretion of their manager/supervisor and with approval from the Executive Committee.
  - A. Employees receiving a \$35.00 per month allowance shall be required to provide their manager/supervisor and related Vice President with their most current personal cellular telephone number.
  - B. Providing an employee with a monthly cellular telephone allowance of \$35.00 shall not be a means to reward employees or merely increase their compensation for a job well done, but rather strictly and solely as a necessity, not a convenience, for them to complete their required job duties.
  - C. Employees receiving a monthly cellular telephone allowance of \$35.00 per month shall have the allowance reflected as part of their wages.
- <u>6014.4</u> Any illegal use of cellular telephones is strictly prohibited.
