DELINEATION OF DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITY STATEMENT Long Beach Council of Classified Employees Local 6108 and Long Beach Community College District Classified Senate

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Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this document is to clarify the different roles that the LBCCE, Local 6108 and the LBCCD Classified Senate fulfill in representing the interests and concerns of classified staff. Each has a distinct charter with differing objectives. Pursuing the objectives of one organization within the framework of the other can be redundant or even counterproductive, diluting the overall effectiveness of the organizations in serving classified employees interests. By clearly understanding each organization's charter, we ensure that classified employees have input into the participatory governance process while at the same time are assured that classified bargaining rights are protected.

This document is an understanding between the LBCCE, Local #6108 and the LBCCD Classified Senate of the roles and responsibilities herein.

Statement of Purpose Long Beach Community College District Classified Senate

The Long Beach Community College District Classified Senate promotes the interests of all district-wide classified employees in accordance with AB 1725 mandates.

The purpose of this organization is to provide a vehicle by which the classified employee is able to fully participate in the process of achieving the goals and mission of the colleges and to promote a successful learning environment for students. It shall be the function of the Classified Senates to participate in the governance of Long Beach Community College District on a consultative level: to actively collect, evaluate, and disseminate information for the classified employee and to represent those interests in non-bargaining unit (LBCCE #6108) issues on any participatory governance committee.

<u>Statement of Purpose</u> <u>Exclusive Bargaining Representative - Long Beach Council of Classified</u> <u>Employees Local 6108</u>

The American Federation of Teachers, LBCCD #6108, hereafter referred to as "AFT Local #6108", shall be recognized as the "exclusive" representative for the classified employees within its bargaining unit. AFT Local #6108 expresses the viewpoint of the classified bargaining unit to the college administration and Governing Board in matters regarding Collective Bargaining.

The rights and responsibilities of AFT Local #6108 derive from the Public Employees Relations Act (SB 160, Rodda), and the interpretations of this Act by the Public Employees Relations Board, the Collective Bargaining Agreement, Past Practice, and other applicable laws. The AFT Local #6108 scope of representation shall include all matters dealing with the collective bargaining process, wages, hours of employment, workload, terms and conditions of employment, classified service on all hiring committees and all areas covered in The Long Beach Council of Classified Employees Local #6108 Collective Bargaining Agreement for Classified Employees.

Joint Responsibilities

It is the joint responsibility of the LBCCD Classified Senate and AFT Local #6108 to ensure that classified staff has meaningful input into the decision-making processes of the District.

It is the joint responsibility of the LBCCD Classified Senate and AFT Local #6108 to work cooperatively to further the perspectives and professionalism of classified staff as to ensure a sound institution of higher education and to support student success. The LBCCD Classified Senate and AFT Local #6108 have a joint responsibility to avoid the development of divisive or discordant positions and/or goals, and to communicate with each other in a clear and timely manner on any issues which may affect classified staff.

Each participatory governance committee with classified employee representation must have an appointee from both the Classified Senates and AFT Local #6108, though sometimes the two constituencies agree to appoint a single classified member.

To ensure that classified representation is consistently speaking with a united voice it is understood that any public position regarding classified staff must be approved by all parties, unless the matter relates to a collective bargaining issue in which case AFT Local #6108 will speak for all its bargaining unit members.

Joint Liaison Committee

The LBCCD Classified Senate / AFT Local #6108 Liaison Committee shall be composed of four (4) members. Said composition shall be the President of the LBCC Classified Senate (1) additional representative of his/her choice from the Senate, and the President of AFT Local #6108 plus one (1) additional representative of his/her choice from the bargaining unit.

Upon a single written request of either Senate President or the President of AFT Local #6108, the Liaison Committee shall convene for the purposes of mediating unresolved conflict in consultation with their respective organizations.

Termination of Statement

This Delineation of Duties/Responsibility Statement may be changed or terminated by any party by giving the other party thirty (30) day notice of its intent to request change or termination. The parties agree to use those thirty (30) days to meet and attempt to resolve any concerns that led to the request.

This document is for informational purposes and is intended to clarify the roles and responsibilities of the LBCCD Classified Senate and AFT Local #6108 within the Long Beach Community College District.
