Standard IC Committee: Institutional Integrity Standard IIA Committee: Instructional Programs

Standard IIB Committee: Library and Learning Support Services

Standard IIC Committee: Student Support Services Standard IIIA Committee: Human Resources

Standard IIIB, IIIC, & IIID Committee: Physical Resources, Technology Resources, and Financial Resources

Standard IVA Committee: Decision-Making Roles and Processes

Standard IVB & IVC Committee: Chief Executive Officer and Governing Board

Term of Appointment

The overall commitment would begin at the start of Spring 2020 and end in Spring 2022. (See the <u>timeline</u> for reference). As of this date, we do not have an exact sense of the weekly or monthly time commitments.

Each applicant shall submit a short statement of interest describing their qualifications and experience. The statement email must be submitted to the Classified Senate President no later than 12/13/2019 at 4:00pm.

Applications will be reviewed, and an appointment will be announced sometime after December 19, 2019, following consultation with the Superintendent-President.
