He served as a panelist for "The Movement in the Music" and hosted the Jazz Dance Conference West "Legends and Legacy" at CSUDH.



MARTHA L. Z. PAMINTUAN is an Associate Professor of Dance at Long Beach City College and a San Francisco Bay Area Native. She earned her MFA in Dance on a full scholarship from the University of California, Irvine and her BA in Dance and a Minor in

Kinesiology from San Francisco State University. Pamintuan is Co-Founder, Co-Artistic Director, and Co-Choreographer of LV Dance Collective based out of the San Francisco Bay Area. She founded the East Oakland Sports Center Introductory School of Dance in Oakland, California serving as the Cultural Arts Program Director/Choreographer. Her work has been awarded and recognized nationally and she has toured internationally throughout the South of Chile, Vietnam, Spain, and Ghana. Martha is also a professional athlete, a runner and swimmer; a fitness professional; a licensed Zumba instructor, ballet barre instructor, water aerobics instructor, swim instructor; an actor; and most importantly a mother and wife.



CLYDEAN PARKER (MAKEDA KUMASI) MFA / M.Ed is the founder of WE 3 PRODUCTIONS, as well as the co-founder and artistic director of The Umoja Ensemble of the Inland Empire. Kumasi is a continuing lecturer at the University of California. Riverside in

the Department of Dance and a recent recipient of California Arts Council Grants as a Culture Bearer.



PROFESSOR STEPHANIE POWELL

Stephanie Powell will be the Artistic Director of the Spring 2024 Dance Ensemble in Concert and Artistic And has been a full-time Dance Faculty at LBCC for eighteen years. She received her B.A. from UC Berkeley in Sociology

and Education and her MFA in Dance from UC Irvine as a Chancellor's Fellow. Powell is certified in the NYCB Workout, Zumba, Qiginition and BASI Pilates with a Dance Specialization. She serves as an adjudicator for dance competitions and has modeled internationally for Redken and Trevor Sorbie of the UK. Ms. Powell danced professionally with Oakland Ballet. San Francisco Opera, Dance Theatre of Harlem, Alvin Ailey American Dance Theatre, and the Los Angeles production of the Lion King. Her appearances on television include the Grammy's, the Jay Leno Show, Tyra Banks FabLife Show, and for artists such as Janet Jackson and Beyonce Knowles. Ms.Powell is the principal interpreteur of the choreographic works for the late choreographer Donald McKayle and stages his work around the world.



LIHUEI SUNG (FIONNA), is a native of Kaohsiung, Taiwan. Mrs. Sung earned her MFA and BFA of Fine Arts degree in Dance, Choreography and Production at California Institute of the Arts (Cal Arts). She is the Founder/Artistic Director for

JESSICA TORRES is a choreographer, lecturer, director, film maker, dancer, actor, and humorist. She received her MFA in Dance from UCI, her MaED at UOP, her BA at LMU, and yoga certification under Srivatsa Ramaswami. Jess is Senior Lecturer at

BERNARD H. GADDIS is Founder and Artistic Director of Contemporary West Dance Theatre & Conservatory (CWDT) is the first professional Contemporary dance company in

the history of Nevada and is now celebration its 16th year. Mr. Gaddis' is also the first person of color to establish a major professional dance company in the state of Nevada. Bernard has choreographed over 32 ballets some of his works can been seen on various dance companies and universities and was recently chosen for the Jacob Pillow ACDA dance festival. Bernard's dance studies began in Philadelphia at the High School for the Performing Arts, where he received numerous awards and scholarships; including a full scholarship to the prestigious Governor's School for the performing Arts, a school for gifted dance students. Mr. Gaddis has also received scholarships to Pennsylvania Ballet, Dance Theater of Harlem, Princeton Ballet, & The Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater. Bernard's first professional dance experience was with the Philadelphia dance company "Philadanco" under the direction of the renowned Joan Myers Brown. Bernard has since been a certified Master Horton and Ballet teacher that has been teaching for the past twenty vears both nationally and internationally to many dancers in Universities and Professional companies.



CYRIAN REED is a graduate of California State University, Long Beach where she received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Dance/Performance. She also earned a Master of Arts Degree

in Education/Adult Education and Training from the University of Phoenix. Reed has worked with artists such as Kanye West, Beyonce, David Foster, Gnarls Barkley, Ceelo, Mitchel Musso, Cheryl Lynn, Trinere, Linear, SNAP, KC and The Sunshine Band, and Choo Choo Soul. She was also a guest judge and choreographer for Steven Spielberg's Reality TV Show on Bravo, "America's Next Top Producer." Recently, Reed choreographed for the Emmy nominated "Hip-Hop-Harry" sitcom on Discovery Kids/ TLC television channels. She has also choreographed for brand commercials such as Nike, Adidas, Sketchers, and Haagen-Dazs ice cream.

Artists and students under her tutelage at the University of California, Irvine, California State University of Northridge, Cypress Community College, Santa Ana College, Long Beach City College, and MiraCosta College have won numerous awards because of her signature choreography. Reed believes that dance can communicate with anyone in the world. By revolutionizing art-of-dance, Reed's compelling, innovative, energetic, diversified teaching techniques, choreography, and performance come through her dancers, commanding all eyes to the stage.
