Open to all students.

**Recommended for students with
a high school GPA of 2.6 or below.**

Extra 1 unit = more time & support in
class to work with the writing
instructor and an embedded tutor

OR

Pre-Transfer Coursework

ENGL 105 Fundamentals of Writing

4 units

**Open to all students who want extra practice with college-level
reading and writing skills before enrolling in transfer-level ENGL 1
or ENGL 1S with support.**

AP Credit: If you score 3 or higher on Language and Writing or a 3 on Literature, submit your College Board transcripts to LBCC Admissions to earn credit for ENGL1 and meet with a counselor or the English Department Head for clearance into ENGL3 or ENGL4.
