Introduction to Film Studies | 3 units

Transferable to UC & CSU

This course serves as an introduction to the evaluation of film as an art form through an analysis an appreciation of its aesthetics, history, literature, creative techniques and expression.

Introduction to Metalworking | 4 units

Transferable to CSU

This course is designed to provide students with a basic introduction to sheet metal fabrication, layout and career opportunities related to the industry and green technologies.

Mechanical Drafting, Introduction | 3 units

Transferable to CSU

An engineering documentation class covering dimensioning and tolerancing, orthographic projection, pictorial views, auxiliary views, and section views. Freehand lettering, sketching and drawing instruments for manual applications, computer aided drafting software techniques and transfer to computer aided manufacturing software programs will be taught.
