LONG BEACH CITY COLLEGE FEDERAL WORK STUDY (FWS)

The Federal Work Study (FWS) program is a federally-funded aid program that provides on-campus work positions to qualifying LBCC students. Students must meet the financial aid requirements to qualify for a position and can apply by completing the FAFSA application by the priority deadline.

ELIGIBILITY

FWS awards are issued on a first-come, first-served basis. Students must meet the following requirements to be consider for FWS:

- 1. Meet SAP Standards
- 2. Minumum 6 unit Enrollment
- 3. Have sufficient unmet need

PAY RATE & HOURS

FWS Students are allowed to work a maximum of 15 hours per week. Students are not able to work during scheduled class times. Pay rate for new FWS Students is CA Minimum Wage. Second year FWS Students are paid CA Minimum Wage + \$0.75.

APPLICATION PROCESS

FWS Students may apply to any of the hiring departments by reaching out to the supervisor and requesting an interview. Students may also complete a Job Interest Card online at: https://forms.office.com/r/v333riTEqX
