Participating School Districts for LBCC Education Course Fieldwork

The LBCC Reading and Teacher Preparation Department and Tomorrow's Teachers Teacher Preparation Program have chosen high quality school districts and schools that meets the fieldwork requirement of your Education course. This includes placement at a public school in the general education classroom of one credentialed teacher who has at least 3 years of experience. Classrooms may not be special education classrooms, computer labs, after school programs, etc. and observation/volunteering must be conducted during regular school hours. Students will either self-place at a participating district or be placed by the Tomorrow's Teachers office.

- Education 10 students will self-place in one of the approved TK-12 districts on this list in a TK-8 classroom.
- Education 20 course students will either self-place in a TK-6 classroom or be placed in a Long Beach Unified School District or other elementary school.

Students are required to attend an orientation to receive placement information and to complete a registration packet. The packet will contain the correct Livescan fingerprinting forms and instructions for your placement type.
