I. PRE-BID INQUIRIES (PBIs) AND RESPONSES

1. Q: **Spec section 102113.17 – 2.2 F.2 – Refers to drawings SK-005 for color selection, I cant find that page? Also on the same detail in the spec but #3 it calls for “Edge Color: Through-color matching facing sheet color.” Phenolic panels do not come with the same color on the edges that the face is. Phenolic partitions are typically black core, so the edges will be black, is this acceptable?**

A: *The drawings on SK-005 are the last page of the Bid 22-008 Veterans Stadium Restroom Partition Replacement Drawings which can be found on the Long Beach City College Current RFP/RFQ & Bid Opportunities website (link here: <https://www.lbcc.edu/pod/current-rfprfq-bid-opportunities>) or can be downloaded directly as a PDF (from this link here: [https://www.lbcc.edu/sites/main/files/file-attachments/bid\\_22-008\\_vets\\_stadium\\_restroom\\_partition\\_replacement\\_specs\\_0.pdf?1652159452](https://www.lbcc.edu/sites/main/files/file-attachments/bid_22-008_vets_stadium_restroom_partition_replacement_specs_0.pdf?1652159452)). Also, it is acceptable for the edge face color to match the core color for the phenolic panels.*

2. Q: **Please verify in addition to B license, and EPA lead safe certification is required. Since per the report provided tiles in both restrooms have traces of lead, and installation of partitions will require making new holes or re-drilling the same hole.**

A: *Yes, an EPA lead safe certification is required to do work with the lead containing tiles in the restrooms.*

3. Q: **Some contract documentation included in the original bid is missing from the new contract, most importantly “bid\_22-006\_project\_specs\_and\_photos.pdf”, in this document the partition material has been indicated.**

A: *Please disregard all prior documentation from previous bids, the only documents that will be considered applicable to this bid were included with this Bid 22-008 and any addendums released specifically for this bid number.*
