LBCCD-LBCCFA Memorandum of Understanding Behavioral Health & Substance Abuse Benefits

This following Memorandum of Understanding ("Agreement") is made by and between the Long Beach Community College District ("District") and the Long Beach City College Faculty Association ("LBCCFA"). Where appropriate, The District and LBCCFA will collectively be referred to as "parties." This Memorandum of Understanding shall supersede any other agreement, either oral or written, previously agreed to by the parties related to the following:

- 1. The parties agree to the following changes to Health and Welfare benefits offered by the District to those employees and retirees covered in the collective bargaining agreement per Article 6:
 - The behavioral health and substance abuse coverage currently offered through MHN shall cease as of December 31, 2020.
 - Behavioral health and substance abuse coverage shall be added to the Anthem HMO and Anthem PPO plans effective January 1, 2021.
 - The current Kaiser plan contains behavioral health and substance abuse coverage and no changes are being made to that plan.
 - The Employee Assistance Program "EAP" shall be transitioned from MHN to Anthem effective January 1, 2021.
- 2. Employee contributions shall continue as defined in Article 6.4 of the collective bargaining agreement.
- 3. The District will continue to consult with LBCCFA should it be necessary to make any other changes to Health and Welfare benefits.
- 4. As a reference, the attached July 1, 2020 renewal costs are incorporated for information purposes only.
- 5. Any future changes to rates will be presented to the Health and Welfare Committee as an information item in line with our usual practice and implemented on the dates new rates may become effective.
