# Online Teaching Certification | Teach Online Seminar 3.0

If you are a faculty member that has been assigned or would like to be assigned a Distance Learning (Hybrid or Fully Online) Course at LBCC then you are required to have official online teaching certification. At LBCC this requires the completion of **Teach Online Seminar** (also known as **TOS 3.0**).

#### **HOW TO ENROLL & LOG INTO TOS 3.0**

You self-enroll through our Canvas LMS platform by following these steps (view image on page 2):

- Step 1: Log into your Canvas account at <a href="https://lbcc.instructure.com">https://lbcc.instructure.com</a>
- Step 2: Select "Resources" from the navigation list on the left.
- **Step 3:** Click on the "LBCC Online Teaching Certification" option. This will open the enrollment page and syllabus of our Teach Online Seminar 3.0.
- **Step 4:** Click on the button "Enroll in TOS 3.0 LBCC Teach Online Seminar" and follow the steps for completing the online form.

Once you self-enroll you will then have instant access to the course. The course will appear on your dashboard list of Canvas classes. You can also find a link to the course in Canvas by selecting the left dark gray navigation "Resources" >> "LBCC Online Teaching Certification"

TOS has four main Modules. Each Module has units which consist of deliverables that faculty will complete. Overall there are 10 deliverables.


