For your convenience, you may also refer to the list below for the required online teaching trainings.

- REQUIRED: Online Teaching & Learning Pedagogy Certification (LBCC Teach Online Seminar 3.0).
  The options are:
  - o Option 1) This requirement is met by completing our self-paced <u>LBCC Teach Online</u> Seminar 3.0 (TOS 3.0) or
  - o Option 2) Online Teaching Certification Waiver This requirement can be waived with submission & approval of Online Teaching Pedagogy Certification from another institution or through an organization such as @One which is equivalent to our Teach Online Seminar.
- 2. REQUIRED: Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) Certification. The options are:
  - o Option 1) completing our <u>LBCC Introduction to Teaching with Canvas</u> self-paced course and receiving the certification badge for completion
  - o Option 2) by submitting a <u>Canvas Certification Waiver</u> This requirement can be waived with submission & approval of Canvas Certification from another institution or through an organization such as @One which is equivalent to our Growing with Canvas course.

PLEASE NOTE: Online Teaching Pedagogy Certification (i.e. TOS 3.0) is focused on pedagogical approaches to Distance Learning and is not the same as Canvas LMS training.
